Title: Employee Abuse Of Your Company's Technology Resources

Introduction:

Through real-life examples, this presentation will examine how employees are abusing technology resources and how this abuse impacts the employer. This presentation will cover examples of how trusted insiders have taken advantage of their employer's technology resources, the type of data most susceptible to employee theft, and what an employer should do if they suspect abuse/misuse. The process for conducting an investigation involving technical assets will be covered and will highlight the pitfalls to avoid. New Jersey case law that highlights the importance of proper investigative techniques will also be discussed.
